Present simple and continuous

The present simple has the following uses.

regular events and processes We hold four meetings a year. We don't usually start till 9 o'clock. How often do you travel on business?

Key words

a week/month/year, always, ever, never, often, rarely, seldom, sometimes, usually

- facts that will not change
 Our company manufactures mobile phones.
 Where do you export to?
 I don't take sugar in coffee.
- timetables and scheduled events When does the plane leave? The conference starts at 9:30 am.

The present continuous has the following uses.

events happening now I'm working on a project to promote sales. Our sales are growing fast. Are you enjoying your new job?

Key words

now, at the moment, currently

- temporary situations We're attending a training course this week. I'm not working at head office at the moment. Are you staying at the new hotel?
- future arrangements
 Where are we meeting on Friday?
 My colleague isn't coming to the meeting.

The continuous is not usually used with the following stative verbs.

- verbs that express opinions or feelings like, dislike, hate, prefer, want, believe, think, feel, mean, understand, realise, recognise
 Exception: We're thinking about your proposal. (=considering)
- verbs of the senses see, hear, feel, smell, taste, seem
 Exception: I'm seeing him tomorrow (=meeting)
- verbs of ownership
 have, need, want
 Exception: We're having lunch tomorrow.
 (have doesn't indicate ownership)
