

## Pronunciation of final «-s» revision and exercise

The pronunciation of words ending in S depends on the final consonant (sound). There are three ways to pronounce the S:

/iz/	<b>/s/</b>	<b>/z/</b>
SIBILANT	VOICELESS	VOICED
C races	P sleeps	B crabs
S buses	K books	D words
X boxes	T hats	G bags
Z prizes	F cliff	L deals
SS kisses	PH graphs	M dreams
CH watches	TH myths	N fans
SH dishes	Voiced Sound	NG sings
GE changes	uses the vocal cords	R wears
Sibilant Sound	and it produces a	V gloves
a hissing or 🖉	vibration or humming	Y plays
buzzing sound	sound in the throat
