USING A OR SOME

PLURAL COUNT NOUNS

There are *some computers* in the lab. I'd love to have *some oranges*. There are *some tornadoes* every year.

some + plural count noun → things (not specific)

USING A OR SOME

NONCOUNT NOUNS

I need some exercise.

The children would like some fruit.

I think the cat needs some attention.

some (∅) with noncount noun

→ something not specific

SINGULAR COUNT NOUNS






