Answer

As a member of my College Theatre Society, I helped organise a visit to the West Yorkshire Playhouse for twenty-five people to see *Hamlet*.

My role was to arrange travel and accommodation for anyone wishing to take part. I promoted the event by using posters across the campus and emailing Society members, emphasising the main benefits of the visit. I also set a deadline for payment to create an efficient cash-flow. Based on this I arranged a mini-bus and negotiated a reduced rate booking at the Leeds Youth Hostel.

As an additional ten students expressed an interest after the deadline, I decided to change my plans. To cope with this, I ordered a larger bus and secured extra accommodation with the Hostel. The visit was a huge success receiving positive feedback and staying within our budget, while generating £25 revenue for the Society from a raffle held on the trip.
